## **COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS**

September 23, 2025

<u>Digby & Area Foodbank Community Grant Application</u> - Municipal Council approved the Digby & Area Foodbank's community grant application in the amount of \$2,000.

<u>Sewer Rates</u>- Municipal Council agreed to start the process of increasing sewer rates, including a raise in the frontage fee to \$150 and unit rate to \$300, and the implementation of a new connection fee of \$150.

<u>Foster for Cats Funding</u>— Municipal Council approved the Foster for Cats request for additional operational funding in the amount of \$2,000.

**FCM - Community Risk Assessment** – Municipal Council agreed to submit an application for the FCM Community Risk Assessment.

<u>Highway 101</u>—Municipal Council agreed to write a letter to MLAs and municipal units from Annapolis through to Argyle, inviting them to participate in the reestablishment of the Highway 101 Taskforce and copy MLA Jill Balser, Minister Fred Tilley, and MP Chris d'Entremont.

<u>Property Tax Exemption Request (AAN #00061247)</u> – Municipal Council approved adding property #00061247 (7206 Hwy 101, Plympton) under the Property Tax Exemption By-Law.

<u>Thank You Letter to Fire Departments</u> – Municipal Council agreed to send a letter to all 11 fire departments acknowledging their hard work and thanking them for their services during the Long Lake Wildfire.

<u>J-Class Road List</u> - Municipal Council agreed to submit the J-Class Road list to the province. Included in the request for repaving is Water Street in Freeport and Sissiboo Street in Weymouth.
